A reading from the First Book of Kings

The Lord appeared to Solomon in a dream and said, 'Ask what you would like me to give you.' Solomon replied, 'Lord, my God, you have made your servant king in succession to David my father. But I am a very young man, unskilled in leadership. Your servant finds himself in the midst of this people of yours that you have chosen, a people so many its numbers cannot be counted or reckoned. Give your servant a heart to understand how to discern between good and evil, for who could govern this people of yours that is so great?' It pleased the Lord that Solomon should have asked for this. 'Since you have asked for this' the Lord said 'and not asked for long life for yourself or riches or the lives of your enemies, but have asked for a discerning judgement for yourself, here and now I do what you ask. #### THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED **VIRGIN MARY**

#### **TUESDAY 15TH AUGUST**

The Assumption of Mary is one of the four Marian Dogmas of the Catholic Church. Pope Pius XII defined it on 1st November 1950 in his Apostolic Constitution titled Munificentissimus Deus as follows:

We proclaim and define it to be a dogma revealed by God that the immaculate Mother of God, Mary ever virgin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a Holy Day of Obligation, which means that every Catholic MUST attend Mass on this day.
