TRINITY SUNDAY

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON

The Spirit of the Lord has filled the whole world and that which contains all things understands what is said, alleluia.

FIRST READING

Proverbs 8: 22-31.

A reading from the Book of Proverbs

The Wisdom of God cries aloud:

The Lord created me when his purpose first unfolded, before the oldest of his works. From everlasting I was firmly set, from the beginning, before earth came into being. The deep was not, when I was born, there were no springs to gush with water. Before the mountains were settled. before the hills, I came to birth; before he made the earth, the countryside, or the first grains of the world's dust. When he fixed the heavens firm, I was there, when he drew a ring on the surface of the deep, when he thickened the clouds above. when he fixed fast the springs of the deep, when he assigned the sea its boundaries - and the waters will not invade the shore when he laid down the foundations of the earth, I was by his side, a master craftsman, delighting him day after day, ever at play in his presence, at play everywhere in his world. delighting to be with the sons of men.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth.

- 1. When I see the heavens, the work of your hands, the moon and the stars which you arranged, what is man that you should keep him in mind, mortal man that you care for him? (R.)

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, by faith we are judged righteous and at peace with God, since it is by faith and through Jesus that we have entered this state of grace in which we can boast about looking forward to God's glory. But that is not all we can boast about; we can boast about our sufferings. These sufferings bring patience, as we know, and patience brings perseverance, and perseverance brings hope, and this hope is not deceptive, because the love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given us.

WATER DAMAGE UPDATE



As you are aware, the Parish had some extensive water damage in the rains over the last few months. The Insurance assessors have been on site and works to fix the damage should begin within the next few weeks. Unfortunately, the damage to the exterior of the church roof and hall guttering is not covered by Insurance and the cost will

have to be met by the Parish. Damage inside St. Benedict's Shrine and Montefano Hall should be covered by insurance. either in part or in full. We will give you more information as work progresses.

Works will also be undertaken to rectify the leaning church wall on the Corner of Neville St and Justin St. This is a major work planned for the July school holidays and will cost the Parish approximately \$80,000.
