So then, my brothers, there is no necessity for us to obey our unspiritual selves or to live unspiritual lives. If you do live in that way, you are doomed to die; but if by the Spirit you put an end to the misdeeds of the body you will live.


During the evening Mass there will be a special blessing for those who wish to have their St. Benedict Medals blessed.
